50M OUTDOOR 'KNOCK DOWN'

NSRA Lord Roberts Centre - 'New' 50m air rifle 'knock down' target range

One of our unused 50m outdoor bays has now been adapted to provide four firing points for 50m bench rest air rifle shooting (.177/.22 up to 12 fp, 16J). Four sets of 'knock down' targets are available with a static paper target above each 'knock down' target for sighting in your rifle.

50m outdoor 'knock down' range rules

1. All air rifles whether loaded or unloaded must face 'down range' at all times.
2. Air rifles to be carried vertically to and from the firing point.
3. All air rifles must be made safe with a breach flag or signal line inserted in the breach or barrel to show that they are clear and unloaded when not being used.
4. Under no circumstances is **anyone** to go forward of the firing points. If there is a target malfunction contact a member of the centre team who will assist. The static targets will be replaced periodically by the centre team.
5. No air rifles or ammunition should be left unattended at anytime on the range.
6. All air rifles must be transported in a case or slip when in the communal areas of the centre (including outdoors). They may only be uncased on the ranges or with express permission from a member of staff.

Evacuation Procedure

If you hear the fire alarm you must:

1. Immediately stop shooting.
2. Place your air rifle on the firing point and make it safe.
3. Exit via the nearest fire exit door.
4. Proceed along the corridor and either leave the building via the reception area or via the fire doors at the far end of the building.
5. Gather at one of the fire assembly points behind the car park.
6. Do not take your air rifle with you.
7. When the emergency is over a Fire Warden will escort you back into the building.
