



2021 Great Britain Drew Team

Selection Policy

Team Officials: R. Dowling (*Captain*), Miss. C. Chan (*Adjutant*)

The Drew Match is an annual postal international smallbore prone rifle competition for junior shooters aged under 21 as of 31st December in the competition year. The course of fire is an English Match (60 shots at 50 metres) shot on NSRA/ISSF approved targets. There are three matches associated with the Drew: a team of ten, a men's team of three, and a women's team of three, each team may have up to two reserves and several officials. Normally, it is a requirement that each team shoot the Match together on the same range at the same time.

The continuing impact from the COVID-19 pandemic on the shooting calendar has necessitated that the 2021 Great Britain Drew Team Selection Policy be revised. This revised policy, which is outlined below, has been designed to afford the NSRA the opportunity to try and hold at least one selection event during what is another extraordinary year. **All individuals* who wish to be considered for team selection will be required to shoot the postal trial.** As a result of the uncertainty associated with the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and the consequent need for flexibility, the Selection Policy is fluid and is therefore subject to change. *'wild cards' are exempt from having to shoot the postal trial.

The 2021 Great Britain Drew Team will be selected from a postal trial:

Only individuals who are British Citizens and aged under 21 on 31st December 2021 may qualify.

- The course of fire is 60 shots at 50 metres and is to be shot on NSRA/ISSF approved targets. The last day of shooting is **Sunday 1st August 2021**.
- The **top ten** competitors from the postal trial will form the team of ten, with 11th and 12th place being the two reserves. The **top 3 men** from the postal trial will form the team of three men, with 4th and 5th place being the reserves. The **top 3 women** from the postal trial will form the team of three women, with 4th and 5th place being the reserves. The Match will be shot on the athletes' home range (or any other suitable range) in **August/September 2021**.

The Team Captain may, at his sole discretion, offer places to 'wild cards' who may not have entered the trial.

This is a very important competition. As always, effective witnessing is paramount. Therefore, the NSRA reserves the right to appoint a nominated witness for any trialist.
