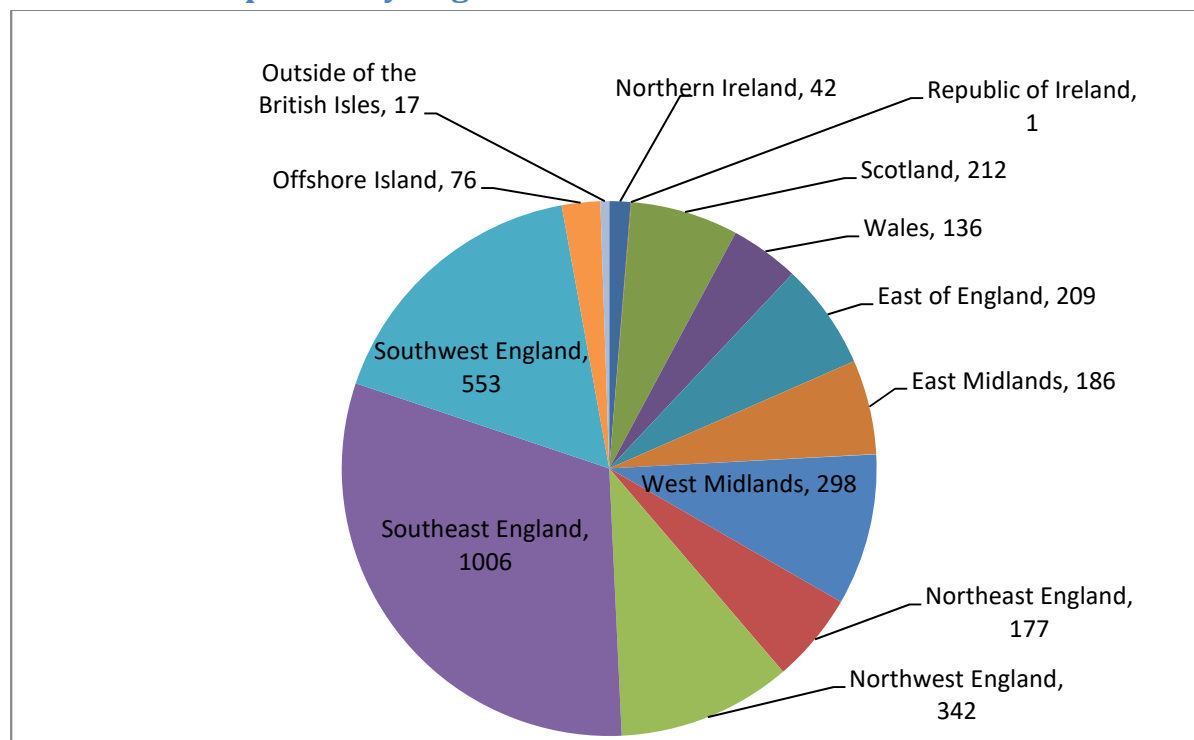


## Preliminary Results of the NSRA Organisational Change Phase 1 Survey

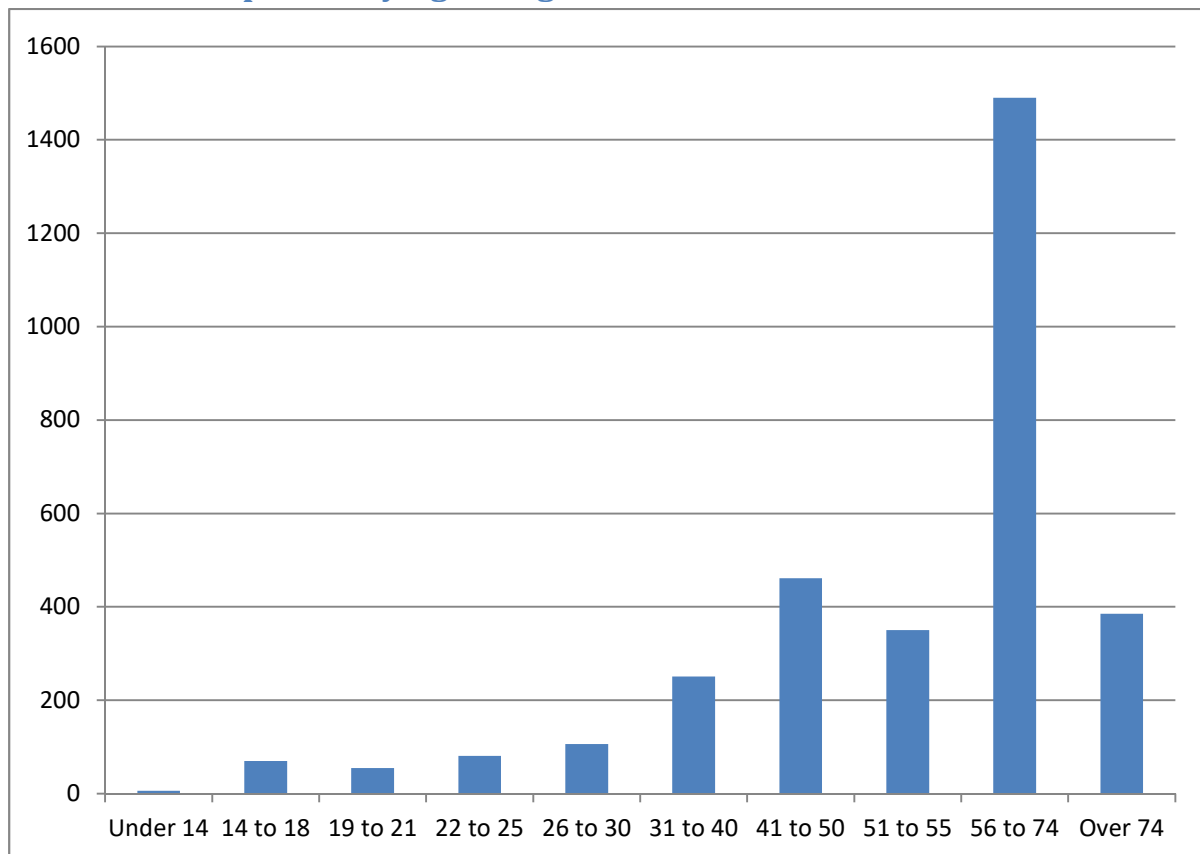

### Number of Responses by Region



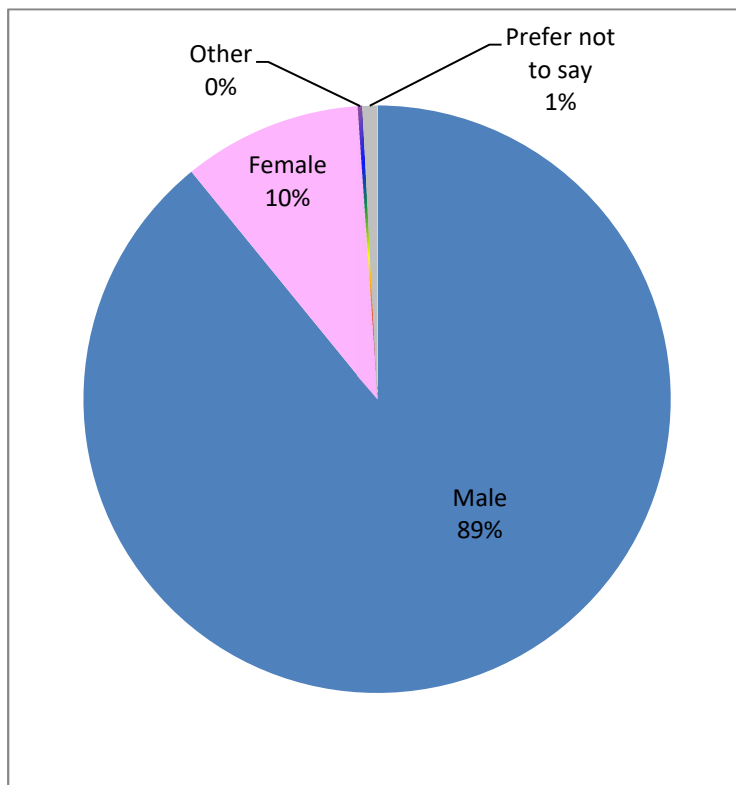

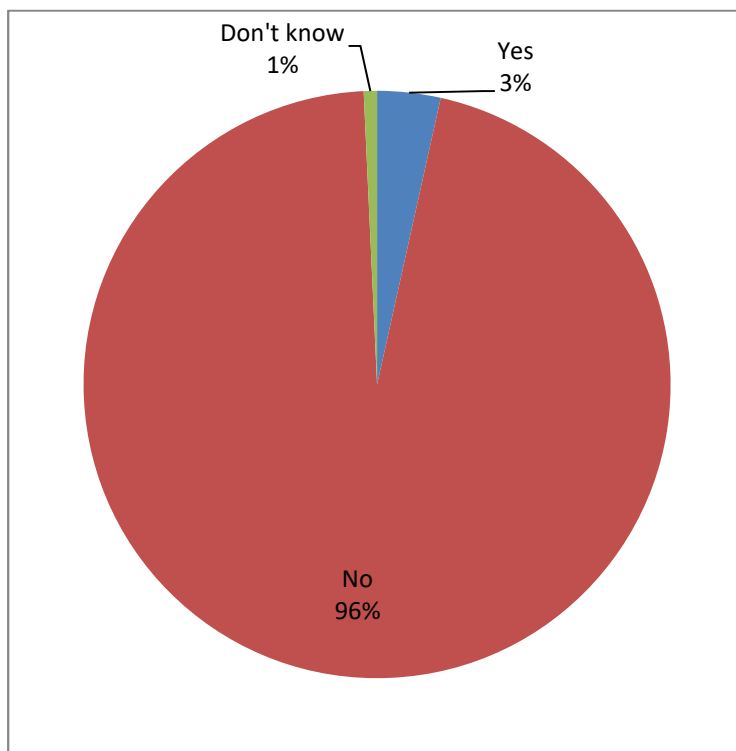

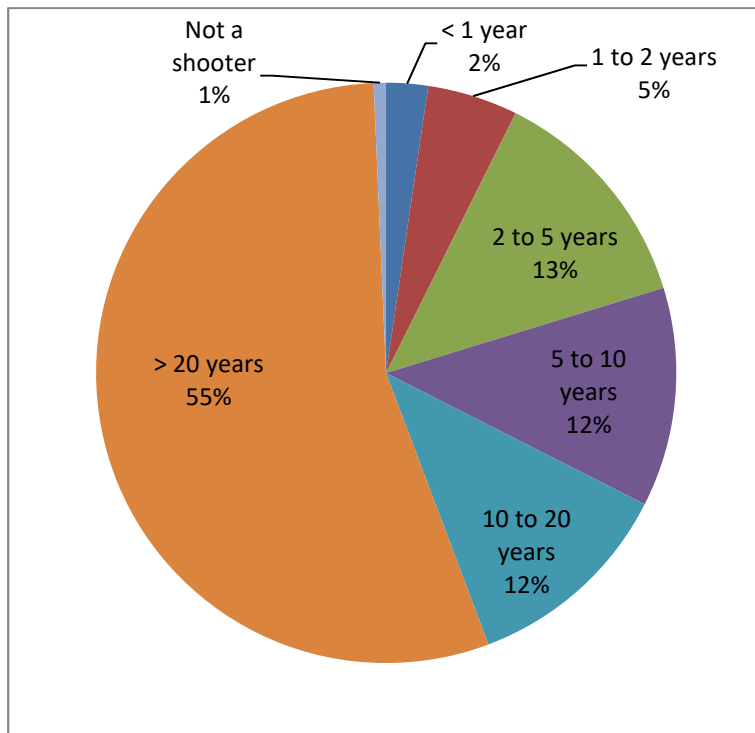

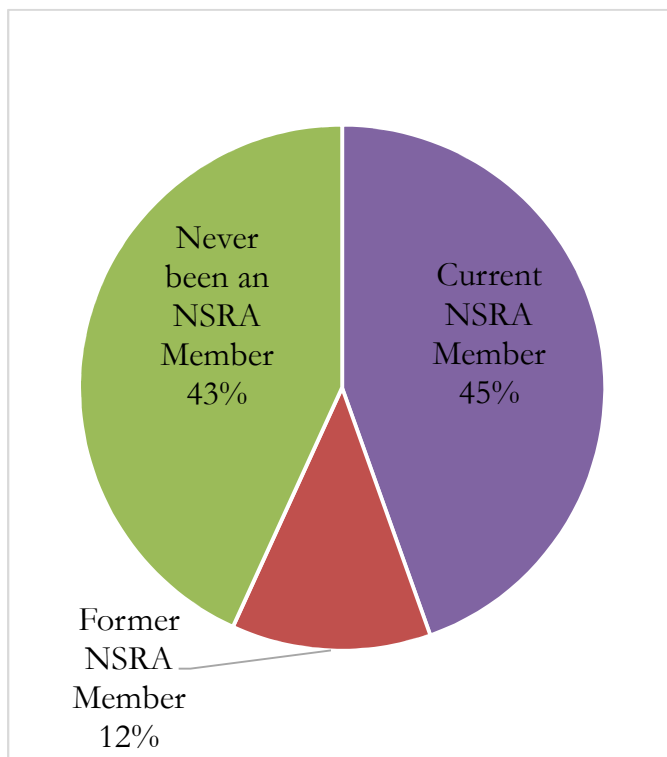

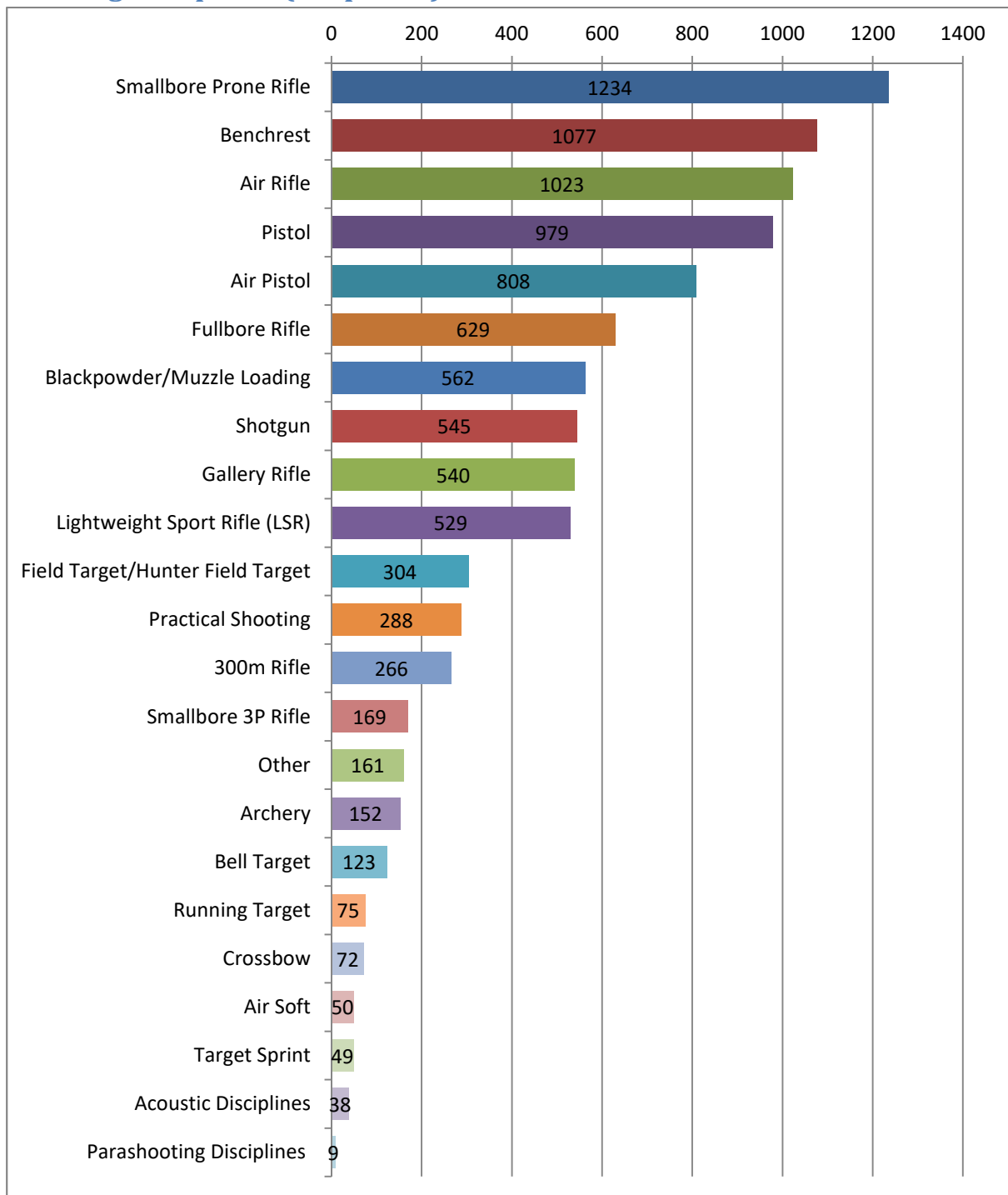
